  - Deut. 16:18-18:22 concerned with the duties of judges, other officials, the king, the Levites, and the prophets
  - Deut. 19:1-26:15 various other laws
- Deut. 26:16-28:68 renewal
  - Deut. 26:16-27:26 Moses describes a ceremony for renewing the covenant made at Mt. Horeb, to take place at Mt. Ebal near Shechem after crossing the Jordan River
  - Deut. 28:1-14 blessings if Israel complies
  - Deut. 28:15-68 curses if they do not
  - New Testament application:
    - Renewal:
      - Rom. 12:2 transformed by the renewing of your mind
      - 2 Cor. 4:16 our inner man is being renewed day by day
      - 2 Cor. 5:17 if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation
      - Eph. 4:23 be renewed in the spirit of your mind
      - Col. 3:10-11 renewed to a full knowledge according to the image of the One who created him, a renewal in which there is no distinction, but Christ is all and in all
      - Tit. 3:5 washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit
    - Blessings:
      - Rom. 4:7 Blessed are those whose lawless deeds have been forgiven, and whose sins have been covered
      - “Blessed are those whose lawless deeds have been forgiven, And whose sins have been covered.
      - Eph. 1:3 God, blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ
      - 2 Cor. 9:6 he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows with blessing will also reap with blessing
      - Gal. 3:14 in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith
